FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY

- Nine of 236 SMEs do business in the food sector in 2019 (3.8%).
- Approximately 8.5% of all the employees in economic operators in the territory of the municipality works in the food sector.
- In all parameters in the food sector, there may be noted growth and positive trends in the period 2015-2017
- Export in the food sector considerably increases from year to year in 2017 share of export in the total income was doubled.
- Three biggest SMEs (medium-size enterprises) in the food sector generate biggest income and employ 75.6% of the total number of employees in this sector.
- Average net personal income in the food sector amounts to BAM 533 and is below the average (77.5% of average personal income in the Prnjavor Municipality (BAM 688)).

- In the food sector there may be noted a trend of growth and development in all analysed parameters, except the income per employee, which is insignificantly below that in 2016.
- In 2017, in the food sector there is one economic operator more in comparison to the previous year.
- Number of employees in 2017 in food industry increased by 71 or 20% in comparison to 2016.
- Generated total income increased by BAM 4.3 million (growth of 11.2%).
- Total income per employee is lower in comparison to the previous year by 7.65%, because the number of employees grows faster than the income number of employees in 2017 increased by 20%, and income increased by 11.2% in comparison to the previous year.
- Share of income in the food sector in the total income of SMEs in the Prnjavor Municipality in 2017 is, as usual, somewhat above 6% (6.87% in 2017, and 6.24% in 2016).
- Sector of food industry makes profit, and in 2017 profit was generated by 35.5% more than in 2016. In 2017, share of profit in the total profit of SMEs amounts to solid 6.24% (approximately 1% less than in 2016).
- Profit per employee in 2017 increased by 16.2% in comparison to 2016.
- Share of income from export in the total income of economic operators doing business in food industry has doubled in comparison to 2016.
- In 2017, the food sector employed approximately 11% of all the employees in the territory of Prnjavor (about 2.5% more in comparison to 2016).
- Average gross salary and net salary in this sector in 2017 increased by one fifth in comparison to 2016. Gross salary increased by BAM 181 (22.7%), and net salary increased by BAM 120 (22.5%).
